2024/2025 Youth Tournament Trail Entry Form

- Division: Junior (both team members - 8th grade & under) Requires a Junior TBF Membership
- High School both team members (9th – 12th grade) or one team member–9th – 12th grade with a 7th or 8th grade team member. All anglers require a High School TBF Student Angler Federation membership.

No entry fee tournaments. Requires a \$25 - 2024 TBF Active Membership for the division you fish.

- Tournament Trail: Sunday, October 6, 2024, Mark Twain Lake, Hwy 107 Ramp, Junior & High School Event
- Take off: 7:00 AM, Junior Weigh-in: 2:00 PM, High School Weigh-in: 3:00 PM, **Entry Deadline: Sunday, September 29, 2024**
- Spring 2025 Junior & High School Event, TBA
- Spring 2025 Junior & High School Event, TBA (HS State Championship)
- Spring 2025 Junior & High School Event, TBA

Juniors: Qualify to advance to the 2025 TBF Junior World Championship, 2024 date and lake TBA in May. **Two Ways to Advance!** For the trail, ranking will be by total AOY Points. One Team advances for every 20 unique teams in the tournament trail. For the Junior State Championship event, one team advances for every 10 teams that compete.

High School: Qualify to advance to the 2025 – TBF Student Angler Federation High School Fishing National Championship, June 2025, Grand Lake, Grove, OK. **Two Ways to Advance!** For the trail, ranking will be by total AOY Points. One Team advances for every 20 unique teams in the tournament trail. Note: High School Anglers trail AOY points will include points earned by competing in the TBF Student Angler Federation Missouri High School State Championship, lake and date to be announced. High School Anglers competing in the TBF Student Angler Federation State Championship one in 10 teams advance at this event.

Note: The dual event TBF Student Angler Federation High School Fishing World Finals with the High School National Championship, June 2025 – Grand Lake, Grove, OK is open to all TBF Student Angler Federation Members and does not have qualification requirements only the High School Fishing National Championship contenders must qualify.

This is a “team” event consisting of two Junior or High School anglers and one (1) non-fishing boat captain/coach, single anglers CANNOT register for this event pursuant to the Federal Safe Sports Act there MUST be 3 people in each boat. NO exceptions.

A PROPERLY COMPLETED ENTRY FORM AND SIGNED PARTICIPANT RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM MUST BE RECEIVED BY Missouri TBF Bass Federation (MO-TBF) ON OR BEFORE THE DEADLINE DATE.

Pre-takeoff Meeting: All Teams must register and check-in at take-off site 45 minutes prior to take-off. There is no practice period or off-limits period prior to the start of on-site registration.



Point Standings: For each division 200 points are awarded to the winning team of each tournament, 198 to 2nd, 196 to 3rd, etc... Every team participating in a tournament receives a minimum of 20 points. Teams must earn weigh credit to receive points (above the minimum) for their finish. Any team that is unable to fish because his or her boat captain withdrew from competition after the pre-tournament meeting and a replacement is not available will receive 20 points. Final points standings in each division - ties are resolved by total weight, then total number of fish, then total number of live fish. If a tie remains it will be broken by lottery. The top team(s) in each division will be eligible to advance based upon the number of unique teams competing in the tournament series defined by The Bass Federation National Youth Program – Juniors – 1 team for every 20 unique teams competing in the series. High School – 1 team for every 20 teams competing in the series. If a qualified team is unable to attend a National Championship the next team in the point standings may be invited.
