Juniors: Qualify to advance to the 2025 TBF Junior World Championship, 2025 date and lake TBA in April/May. Two Ways to Advance! For the trail, ranking will be by total AOY Points. One Team advances for every 20 unique teams in the tournament trail. For the Junior State Championship, Table Rock Lake on March 15, 2025, one team advances for every 10 teams that compete.

High School: Qualify to advance to the 2025 – TBF Student Angler Federation High School Fishing National Championship, June 24-28, 2025, Grand Lake, Grove, OK. Two Ways to Advance! For the trail, ranking will be by total AOY Points. One Team advances for every 20 unique teams in the tournament trail. High School Anglers competing in the March 15, 2025, TBF Student Angler Federation State Championship at Table Rock Lake one in 10 teams advance at this event.

Note: The dual event TBF Student Angler Federation High School Fishing World Finals with the High School National Championship, June 24-28, 2025 – Grand Lake, Grove, OK is open to all TBF Student Angler Federation Members and does not have qualification requirements only the High School Fishing National Championship contenders must qualify.







This is a "team" event consisting of two Junior or High School anglers and one (1) non-fishing boat captain/coach, single anglers CANNOT register for this event pursuant to the Federal Safe Sports Act there MUST be 3 people in each boat. NO exceptions.

A PROPERLY COMPLETED ENTRY FORM AND SIGNED PARTICPANT RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM MUST BE RECEIVED BY Missouri TBF Bass Federation (MO-TBF) ON OR BEFORE THE DEADLINE DATE.

<u>Pre-takeoff Meeting: All Teams must register and check-in at take-off site 45 minutes prior to take-off. There is no practice period or off-limits period prior to the start of on-site registration.</u>

Point Standings: For each division 200 points are awarded to the winning team of each tournament, 198 to 2nd, 196 to 3rd, etc... Every team participating in a tournament receives a minimum of 20 points. Teams must earn weigh credit to receive points (above the minimum) for their finish. Any team that is unable to fish because his or her boat captain withdrew from competition after the pre-tournament meeting and a replacement is not available will receive 20 points. Final points standings in each division - ties are resolved by total weight, then total number of fish, then total number of live fish. If a tie remains it will be broken by lottery. The top team(s) in each division will be eligible to advance based upon the number of unique teams competing in the tournament series defined by The Bass Federation National Youth Program – Juniors – 1 team for every 20 unique teams competing in the series. High School – 1 team for every 20 teams competing in the series. If a qualified team is unable to attend a National Championship the next team in the point standings may be invited.
